Section VI -- Health Hazard Data

Route(s) of Entry: Inhalation--Yes Skin--Non irritating* Ingestion--Non toxic

Health Hazards (Acute and Chronic):

Acute: Non-irritating under normal conditions. *Allergic skin reaction possible in sensitive individuals.

Chronic: None known

Carcinogenicity: No Data

Signs and Symptoms of Exposure: Breathing of large quantities of any dust may cause temporary coughing and breathing irritation.

Medical Conditions Generally Aggravated by Exposure: None known.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures: If breathing of large quantities of any dust may cause temporary coughing and breathing irritation, remove to fresh air.

Section VII -- Precautions for Safe Handling and Use

Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled: Handle spillage or waste disposal in the same manner as any dry vegetable product. Spills may be easily cleaned by removing as much dry product as possible and washing remaining spill with water.

Waste Disposal Method: Handle spillage or waste disposal in the same manner as any dry vegetable product.

Precautions to be Taken When Handling Material: Beware of slippery floors if spill occurs in wet areas.

Other Precautions: None known

Section VIII -- Control Measures

Respiratory Protection: Dust masks should be worn when handling material in dusty conditions.

Ventilation: Ventilate as needed to avoid buildup of airborne dust concentrations above permissible levels.

Protective Gloves: Not required for health reasons, unless individual is allergic to kelp or yucca, but gloves will prevent staining of hands.

Eye Protection: Not normally needed unless individual is allergic to kelp or yucca.

Other Protective Clothing or Equipment: Apron recommended for cleanliness.

Work/Hygienic Practices: Normal hygienic practices for cleanliness.
